RANGE RULES

- 1. EYE AND EAR PROTECTION MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHILE IN THE RANGE.
- 2. ALL FIREARMS CURRENTLY IN USE MUST STAY ON THE SHOOTING BENCH AND BE KEPT POINTED DOWNRANGE AT ALL TIMES. DO NOT CONTINUALLY CARRY FIREARMS BETWEEN THE SHOOTING BENCH AND THE REAR BENCH, OR FROM ONE LANE TO ANOTHER.
- 3. ALL LOADING/UNLOADING MUST BE DONE AT THE SHOOTING BENCH. NEVER LOAD A FIREARM AT THE REAR BENCH AND THEN CARRY IT TO THE SHOOTING BENCH. MAGAZINES MAY BE LOADED AT THE REAR BENCH AND CARRIED TO THE SHOOTING BENCH.
- 4. A LOADED FIREARM MUST NOT LEAVE THE FIRING LINE. IF THERE IS A PROBLEM, LEAVE THE FIREARM ON THE SHOOTING BENCH AND FIND A STAFF MEMBER.
- 5. FIREARMS NOT CURRENTLY IN USE MUST BE STOWED IN A CASE. NO UNCASED FIREARMS SHOULD BE SITTING ON THE REAR BENCH. WHENEVER A FIREARM IS MOVED BETWEEN THE SHOOTING BENCH AND THE REAR BENCH, THE ACTION/CYLINDER MUST BE LOCKED OPEN AND VISIBLE.
- 6. SHOOTERS MUST REMAIN BEHIND THE FIRING LINE AT ALL TIMES. IF AN OBJECT IS DROPPED IN FRONT OF THE SHOOTING BENCH, FIND A STAFF MEMBER.
- 7. NO RAPID FIRING OR DRAWING FROM A HOLSTER WITHOUT PRIOR PERMISSION GIVEN FROM THE STAFF.
- 8. ANY UNINTENTIONAL DISCHARGES OR INJURIES MUST BE IMMEDIATELY REPORTED TO A STAFF MEMBER. ANY DAMAGES THAT YOU CAUSE ARE YOUR RESPONSIBILITY.
- 9. NO FOOD OR DRINKS ARE ALLOWED IN THE RANGE.

THESE RULES EXIST TO MAINTAIN A SAFE AND ENJOYABLE ATMOSPHERE. PLEASE DO YOUR PART TO MAKE SURE EVERYONE ENJOYS THEIR TIME IN THE RANGE.
